## **Guidelines for Returning Seeds**

**Dry:** Make sure seeds are dry.

**Clean:** Have seeds reasonably cleaned by removing as much of the chaff as possible.

**Properly saved:** Only return seeds from plants that you know how to save properly.

**Label! Label! Write** as much information on the packet as possible. Remember that people only have what you have written on the package to decide if it is a plant that they would like to grow. More info is better.

**Share the abundance:** If you have lots of seeds, considering making multiple packets of the same seeds.
