

April 2023 Event Guide

2023 marks the 22nd year that the One Book project has brought Northland communities together to celebrate reading. This year the One Book Northland committee has selected *The Wolf's Trail: An Ojibwe Story, Told By Wolves* by local author Dr. Thomas D. Peacock. *The Wolf's Trail* tells of Zhi-shay', an elder wolf, and a litter of young wolves living somewhere on the side of a hill overlooking the river that flows through Nagahchiwanong in northern Minnesota. Zhi-shay', who knows the whole story of the parallel relationship between wolves and the Ojibwe going all the way back to the Beginning, shares it with his nieces and nephews, and us. Replete with universal lessons, The Wolf's Trail is the story of the Ojibwe, told by wolves, of what they were and have become, and the promise of their becoming.
