DONATION FAQs

When is the last day to donate items?

The last day to donate items is Monday, May 5. After May 5, please hold off on donations until AFTER July 1.

Where should I bring my donation?

Bring your items to the Main Library at 520 W. Superior Street. If you have a bag or small box of books, you can bring it to the Circulation Desk on the Superior St. level.

What if I have A LOT of items to drop off?

If you have more than a few items to drop off and need assistance, you can go directly to the library's loading zone on Michigan Street between 10am and 4:30pm. Ring the doorbell near the garage door and a staff person can bring out a cart to help get things inside!

What items are accepted?

Clean and gently-used materials including hardcover and paperback books, both fiction and nonfiction; music CDs and audiobooks; DVDs, both feature and documentary.

What items are not accepted?

We cannot accept magazines, VHS, encyclopedia sets, textbooks, phonograph records, Condensed Reader's Digest, romance series, catalogs, audio cassettes, or damaged items.
